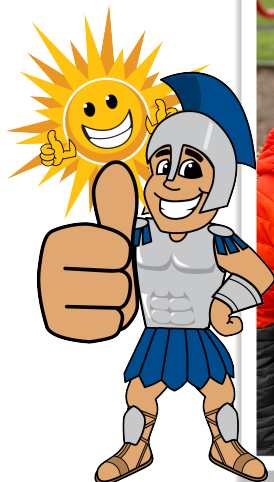


Holy Trinity Catholic School

Significant upgrades were made to our technological infrastructure to support success.

Holy Trinity Catholic School made bold moves to increase the wifi speeds, signal and support for this busy year. Mrs. Katie Walker joined our staff as Digital Learning Coordinator. She helped staff, parents, and students with Zoom, email, connectivity, broken screens, Chromebook loans, and more. Her greatest achievement might be setting each teacher up for their live streaming, making SmartBoards, projectors, iPads, document cameras and laptops all talk to each other and send our teacher’s voices into the world wide web.



HTCS contracted with Comcast to upgrade to fiberoptic cables. As the first and only business to need fiberoptic in our neighborhood, we faced a county timeline, digging, installation and delays. Since install, we run 150+ devices simultaneously with live streaming and are nearly problem free! The school purchased additional chrome books, iPads, laptops for teachers, microphones, stands, speakers and all sorts of tech devices to make lessons easier to teach and learn.

- HT moves to FACTS for our student information system (no SchoolSpeak).



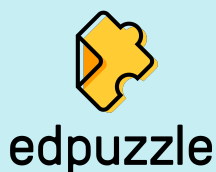

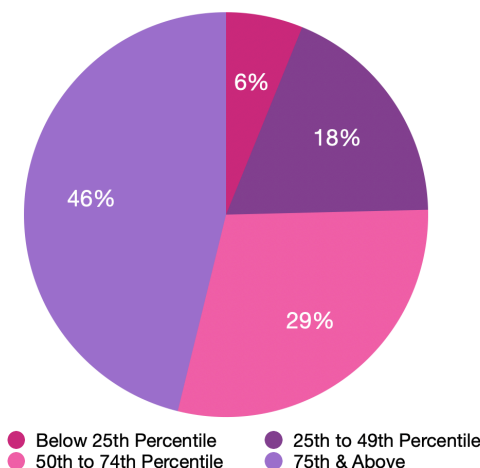

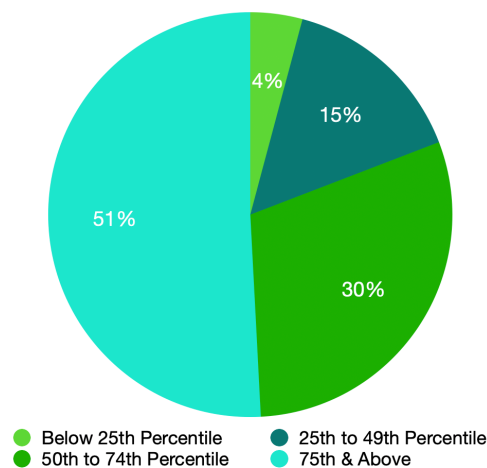
STAR Reading and Math Scores

2020-2021 STAR Reading Scores

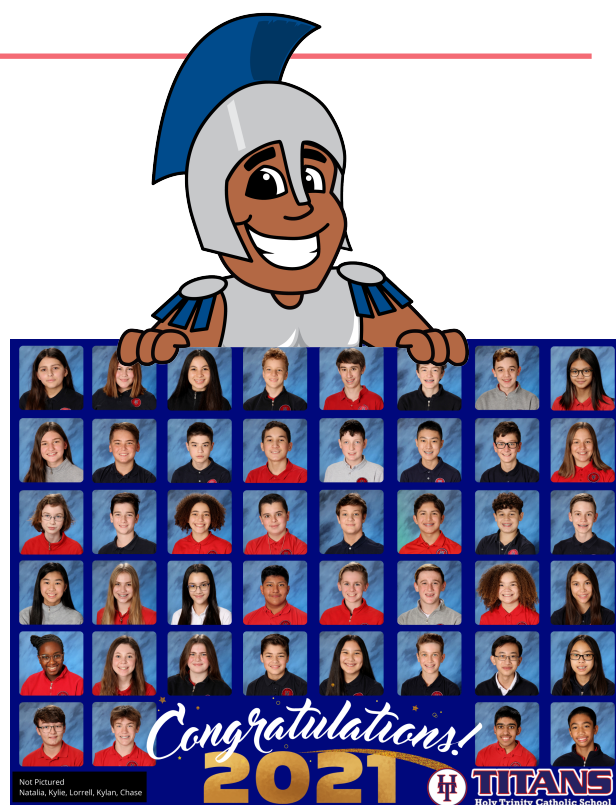


2020-2021 STAR Math Scores

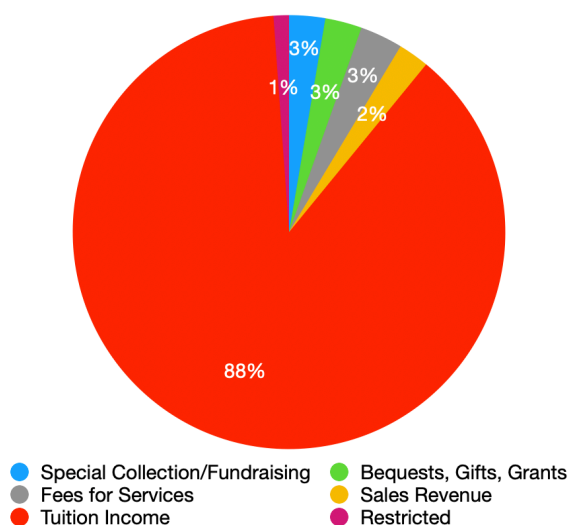

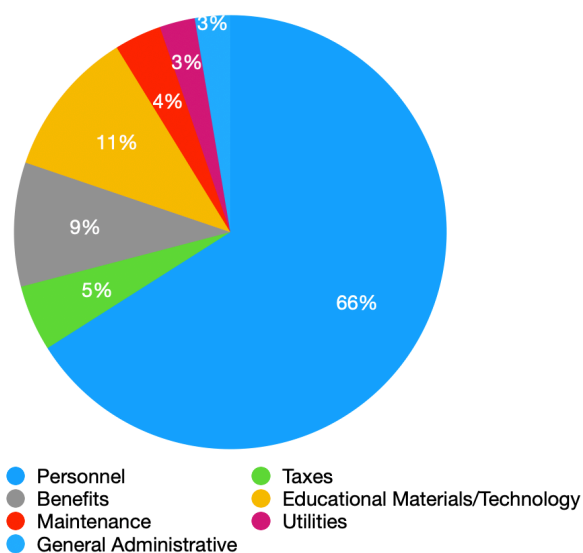
