



ALICE INFORMATION AND RESOURCES

With direction from the Archdiocese of Portland, Holy Trinity Catholic School uses a strategy for lockdown procedures known as ALICE. ALICE is an acronym for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter and Evacuate. The philosophy of ALICE is to use technology and information in a way so that staff and students can make informed decisions in a crisis, remove as possible from the danger zone, and provide realistic training so that those involved in a crisis have a better chance of surviving.

We would like to share some helpful resources to help facilitate your understanding of our implementation as well as help guide conversations at home.
