# **ALL STUDENTS (PRE-K - 8TH GRADE)**

- Backpack

# **Note for Middle School Families:**

For the 2023-2024 school year, Holy Trinity Middle School will continue a required and graded organizational system, including materials management of binders, folders, returned work, homework and planners. Results from several independent studies conducted over the past ten years have pointed consistently to the relationship between success in school, academically and socially, and competency in executive function skills.

During the year, 6th, 7th and 8th grade students will complete a required Study Skills course covering materials management, time management, study strategies, learning strengths, goal setting, decision making and problem solving. This class will be graded. In the first week of school, middle school students will learn how to set up their binder and folders. In past years students have had the freedom to choose organizational styles.
