Action Items:

- Lindsey Hunt:

 - If we had one, wouldn't we need a license to show a film?
 - Chelsie volunteered to spearhead this, likely in March. Will discuss as it gets closer and we evaluate the appetite for a mid-year all school event.
 - Possible additions for next year:
 - Class art project that can be viewed and sold at wine event? How do we go about talking with Mrs. Romero about this idea?
 - Incorporate art show with spring music concert?
 - Talent & Art Show: There hasn't been one at HT for the last 8+ years, minus a virtual one in '20. Talk to Ashley about the pitfalls and see if we could overcome them to have the event next year.
 - Have Coffee & donuts with Principal on a Friday each month?
 - Talk to Ashley about Recess: Communicate the need and **possibly** mandating recess duty - some ideas are each family is responsible for 1-recess

per each child attending HT or somehow getting more parents involved in recess duty. Perhaps have each class own a month?

- Christmas Popcorn next year? Or redistribute funds to other budget line items?
- Book Fair: Britt need/want any help from Lindsey next year?
- Check with Andreis if she wants to beef up our volunteer arm and be a volunteer coordinator. We haven't had one of these in the past.
- Send out survey: ID optimal timing for PTO meetings next year
- Treasurer: We need to find one for next year. Ask whole school or recruit someone specific? Chat with Ashley.
- 8th grade is down as the ones coordinating the MS dance but last year Ashley was heavily involved so we should check with her on what support/leadership 8th grade can give.
