Cost per student: \$175 per year, includes state conference & t-shirt (\$3 per hour for after school program)

\$55 One-time Junior Thespian induction fee * includes a t-shirt designed by HT thespians This covers my dramatics subscription, my initiation, the international thespian fee, as well as membership for the rest of the school year due by September 30

\$75 Holy Trinity yearly fee for the program *due by November 30

\$45 per thespian to attend the Oregon Thespian State Conference in Salem with close to 2,000 other students. Students will attend drama workshops and be able to watch the two best plays / musicals in Oregon as judged by a panel Friday, April 4th (no school) & Sat. April 5th in Salem *due by March 10

- ★ Create and perform skits for school events such as assemblies

- ★ Create, plan and assist with the thespian induction ceremony each Spring
- ★ Attend the Oregon State Thespian conference in April
- ★ Provide leadership for younger drama students
- ★ Create and assist with drama fundraisers
- ★ Serve as camp counselors for the annual Dramafest event at Holy Trinity in May
